Minister Dacic: Demolitions of ISIS remind of church demolition at Kosovo

Minister Dacic said that demolition of cultural goods carried out by ISIS in the Middle East resembles a demolition of Orthodox churches and monasteries in Kosovo and he stressed that it is illogical that one group world considers terrorists, and the second group is trying to get reward by membership in UNESCO.

The only way to fight terrorism is unique and that is to have the same target, said the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Serbia Ivica Dacic, adding that the large forces need to make big difference between liberation movements and terrorist groups, as relative terms, backed by political interests in certain regions.

"The great diplomatic victory of Serbia has shown that not everything can be achieved by pure political force," concluded Dacic, who delivered the final lecture at the International Conference at the University of John Naisbitt in Belgrade.

He stressed that the ISIL as terroristic organization was created 10 years ago and not only a year ago and he asked why it took the entire world so long to perceive it as a global problem.

Dacic pointed out that Serbia from the beginning joined the Coalition for the fight against ISIL and actively participate in global efforts and has demonstrated as responsible and solider partner, ready to put its capacities in the united front. He also informed that there are a number of people from Serbia as a "foreign fighters" involved in the conflicts in the Middle East which is punishable by imprisonment, as well as recruitment on the territory of our state.
