

The First International Conference on National and International Security

The World Elite at John Naisbitt University

John Naisbitt has organized the First International conference on national and international security, with a view to global challenges, terrorism and the refugee problem in Europe and the world.

The conference was opened by Prof. Dr. Slobodan Pajović, Rector of John Naisbitt University in the presence of the representatives of the Republic of Serbia Government, diplomatic corps, military attaches and numerous participants from Serbia, as well as the region. The special guest speaker was Yoseff Bodansky, the greatest American and world expert in the field of terrorism Adviser to the US Congress for terrorism. He spoke about international aspects of fighting terrorism, with a special view on the appearance of the Islamic State, as well as the possible methods of fighting against this kind of terrorism.

The dangers of Islamic terrorism, as well as terrorism in general were discussed by John Nomikos, Director of the Research Institute for European and American Studies (Greece), Gregory Copley, President of the International Strategic Studies Association (USA), Klaus and Klara Lange, The Institute for Transnational Studies (Germany), Ephraim Issac, The Institute of Semitic Studies (USA), Jonathan Figchel, The Institute for Counter-Terrorism (Israel), Zhang Jiadong, Fudan University (China), Fattesh Prabhu-Parulekar, The Forum for Integrated National Security (India), Johnatan Levy (USA), Ephraim Lapid, Bar-Ilan University (Israel), Doron Zimmermann, Senior Security Advisor, (Switzerland), Marco Lombardi Catholic University - Milan (Italy). The Serbia was represented by dr Darko Trifunovic and dr Zoran Dragisic, Faculty of Security Studies, University of Belgrade, and Miroljub Jevtić, Faculty of Political Sciences, University of Belgrade.

At the opening of the conference, on behalf of Montenegro Government, the participants were welcomed by mr Veselin Veljovic, Security Advisor of President of the Republic of Montenegro.

According to experts, this is the largest international conference on the issue of security to have been organized in the world for the past 20 years.
